# **FRONTENDOR LICENSE**

## 1. Standard License

Frontendor grants you an on-going, non-exclusive license to use the blocks and templates. The license grants permission to **ONE INDIVIDUAL** (the Licensee) or **MULTIPLE INDIVIDUALS** (Team company shared license) to access and use the blocks and templates.

### You CAN:

- Use the blocks and templates to create unlimited End Products.
- Use the blocks and templates to create unlimited End Products for unlimited Clients.
- Use the blocks and templates to create End Products where the End Product is sold to End Users.
- Modify the blocks & templates to create derivative blocks and templates.
- Use the blocks and templates to create End Products that are open source and freely available to End Users.

### You **CANNOT**:

- Use the blocks to create End Products that are designed to allow an End User to build their own End Products using the blocks or derivatives of the blocks.
- Re-distribute the blocks or derivatives of the blocks separately from an End Product.
- Share your access to the blocks and templates with any other individuals.

### FOR TEAM:

#### You CAN:

• Everything mentioned above.

#### You **CANNOT**:

- Everything mentioned above.
- Use the blocks to create End Products that are the property of any individual or entity other than the Licensee or Clients of the License.

In simple terms, use Frontendor for anything you like except for projects that compete with Frontendor and would have a negative impact on our product sales 🐇

### 2. Example Usage

Examples of usage **ALLOWED** by the license:

- Upload to any website builder to create your own personal or commercial templates.
- Creating a personal or commercial templates for yourself.
- Creating a template for a client that will be owned by that client.
- Creating a commercial template where end users have to pay a fee to use.
- Creating a template where the primary purpose is clearly not to simply re-distribute the blocks that is free and open source, where the source code is publicly available.

Examples of usage **NOT ALLOWED** by the license:

- Creating a React or Vue version of Frontendor and making it available either for sale or for free. **BUT** contact us if there are talks for cooperation opportunities.
- Creating a "website builder" project where end users can build their own websites using blocks included with or derived from Frontendor.
- Upload to any "website builder
- Creating a template using the blocks and making it available either for sale or for free.
